The Friends of the Southbury Public Library Inc. raises funds through book sales and membership fees and donations to support the Southbury Public Library and its programs and to foster its relations with the Southbury Community. This year we are awarding three merit-based scholarships (one for \$1,000; two for \$500) to a Southbury resident who is a graduating high school senior planning to continue their education in the 2022/23 academic school year. We have 4 points of consideration: academics, extracurricular activities, a written essay, and a candidate's library activities (volunteer hours and program participation). Completed scholarship applications (with this addendum sheet attached) are to be turned in to the Pomperaug High School Career Center on or before Wednesday March 29th or to the Reference Librarian at the Southbury Library on or before Monday April 4th.
